When to Call Us:

If you experience any of the following inform your healthcare professional **immediately**:

- Shortness of breath/chest pain (If you have extreme chest pain, call 911)
- Fever higher than 101°F or shaking chills
- Excessive bleeding or bruising
- Irregular or rapid heartbeat

The following symptoms need to be reported **within 24 hours**:

- Vomiting that is unrelieved by prescribed medications
- Severe constipation or diarrhea or blood in the stool
- Painful or frequent urination or blood in the urine
- Extreme fatigue
- Soreness, redness, swelling, pus, or drainage at your catheter site
- Pain in a new place or pain that is not relieved by your pain medication
- Headache that is not relieved by over the counter medications
- Inability to eat for more than 24 hours and continued weight loss
- Mouth sores that interfere with your ability to eat or drink
- Nasal congestion, drainage, cough
- Any new numbness or tingling in hands or feet
- One or more of the following signs of dehydration
 - Dry, cracked lips or sticky tongue
 - Increased thirst and/or decreased urination
 - Increased weakness/dizziness/lightheadedness
